McCormick, of the third part - all of the County of Fairfax and State of Virginia - Whereas, the said Willis B. McCormick stands bound as the security of the said Ellzey T. Sheid, in two Bonds of Two hundred and eighteen Dollars and twenty nine Cents each - payable to H. W. Thomas, Commissioner, in case of Sheid ag^t Conrad, in the Circuit Superior Court of Law and Chancery for Fairfax County, dated the 19th day of February 1849, and payable at twelve and Eighteen Months without interest; And the said Ellzey T.
