This Indenture, made and entered into this 16th day of January, in the year of our Lord, One thousand eight hundred and fifty. Between William W. Ball, of the first part and William H. Dulany of the second part, both of the County of Fairfax and State of Virginia. Whereas, the said William W. Ball, is justly indebted to Spencer M. Ball of the aforesaid County, in the sum of sixteen hundred and thirteen Dollars and twenty three Cents, evidenced by his two several Notes under Seal, the one dated the 23rd day of December 1842 and payable on the 29th day of September 1843; and executed to the said Spencer M. Ball, as the Adm^r of Mottrom Ball, decd., for the sum of Three hundred and five dollars, and fifty five Cents, with Interest thereon from the said 29th day of Sept^r 1843 which said Note has been settled and accounted for the said Spencer M. Ball, with the Estate of the said Mottrom decd; The other a note dated on the 1st day of November 1849, payable on demand to the said Spencer M. Ball (for money paid and advanced by him for the said W. W. Ball) for the sum of Thirteen hundred and seven Dollars, and sixty eight Cents with Interest thereon from date. And whereas the said Spencer M. Ball is bound as security for said W. W. Ball on sundry Notes, to various individuals, among which is a Note payable to E. R. Ford, for One hundred, and forty one Dollars and eight Cents, with Interest thereon from the day of February 1848; One other Note to Nelson Conrad, for One hundred and thirteen Dollars and eighty two Cents, with like interest. One other Note to John Rouzer, assigned by him to M^{rs} A. Scott for about forty Dollars, with Interest from date. One other Note to Orlando Fairfax (now in the hands of T. R. Love) for forty two Dollars with Interest from the 29th day of June 1848. One other Note to Raymond Fairfax for sixty Dollars, due and payable on the first day of the present month, and on two forth-coming Bonds given on Executions upon Magistrate's Judgments in the hands of S.
