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the land allotted to my said brother Thomas of 6 Acres in the same division and Eastwardly by a line to run (from the corner of my said brother's fence on the East side of said run) North fifteen degrees East to the turnpike road 2^d I give and devise to my cousin Lucius Jones, his heirs and assigns forever all the rest and residue of the said land so allotted and set off to me as aforesaid subject nevertheless to the religious trust and use herein after named and declared concerning four acres of the same; and also subject to the payment of my proportion of my deceased mother and uncle Trilus L. Furber's debts, in the event that my interest herein after named in my deceased brother Bushus' Estate shall prove insufficient for the satisfaction thereof 3^d Whereas I have hitherto caused to be surveyed and laid off four acres of the land last mentioned as a site for a church and church yard, I do hereby constitute & declare the same to be forever held by my said devisee, his heirs and assigns in trust solely and exclusively for such use and purposes, and to be improved and dedicated to the uses and purposes of divine worship in such manner and subject to such rules and regulations as shall or may from time to time be prescribed by the Rev^d William Maffitt, The Rev^d Barnahan, the Rev^d Wells Andrews, Rev^d William Hill, the Rev^d John Mathews, Rev^d J. B. Hoge, Rev^d William C. Watson Rev^d Mr. Baker and the Rev^d Samuel D. Hoge and their survivors or survivor, or such persons as they or the survivors or survivor of them, shall or may from time to time nominate and appoint to act in their stead with power to them and the appointees of such appointees in fidei, to direct and control the use, appropriation and dedication of the said four acres of land as a site for a church and church yard as aforesaid, and to the purposes of divine worship.
